Our Grub "wheels" delivered 57 of those meals to our shut-in guests and your Grub servants back at SGUMC served 300 meals to the guests who drove through that evening. We had the first guest in line again at 4:15 PM. By the time we opened the drive-through line at the appointed serving time of 5:00pm, we had 4 rows of cars waiting in our East parking lot. And we received 25 prayer request cards from guests needing our prayers. These prayer requests have been shared with the Pastors, at Prayer Circle, and with the Grub servants to carry these guests through the times of their concern. **Remember, the November Grub on the Run will be Tuesday, November 14th**. It is not necessary to line up at 4:15, or 4:30, or even 4:45. We have been blessed to be able to provide food to everyone who came through the line before 6:00pm.
