4. Does waiting on God mean doing nothing? What does active waiting look like in your life?
5. Read Acts 1:9–17. How did the Apostles spend their time while they waited? What stands out about their choices?
6. What do you sense God is asking you to do during your current waiting season?
7. In verses 21–26, how did the Apostles influence others while they waited? What can we learn from their posture and actions?
8. How can seasons of waiting grow your character, deepen your faith, or sharpen your purpose?

- Where do You want me to move in faith?
- Where have I grown too comfortable?
- What new thing are You stirring in me?
- Holy Spirit, where are You leading me next?
