- What was Moses instructed to do in Number 20:7-8? What did Moses do instead in vv.10-11?
- Why do you think Moses took this approach (reference Exodus 17:6)?
- What does God say to Moses and Aaron in v.12?
- Pastor Susie mentioned the term “disproportionate punishment” — what does this mean?
When going through Numbers 20:1-12, what can seem “unfair”?
- Think of the staff, the rock, and water — what might they symbolize? (Reference 1 Corinthians 10:4 and John 4)
- Despite Moses’ disobedience, why do you think God still allowed water to flow (and flow abundantly!)?
- Where is God telling you to trust Him?
- How can you apply what you’ve learned from this message this week?
