Discussion Questions: —

- The Big Idea Never Lose Your Awe of God
 - What is awe, and what does "awe of God" look like in everyday life?
 - When was the last time you felt deep awe or reverence for God?
 - What are some signs that someone may be losing their awe of God?
- Point #1: From Awe to Idols
 - How do idols form in our lives, even unintentionally?
 - What are some modern-day idols that compete for our worship?
 - How does worship shape who we become, and what does Revelation 4:11 teach us about God's worthiness to be worshiped?
- Point #2: Broken Cisterns
 - What's a cistern?
 - Why do people turn to substitutes for God, even when they know He is the only true source?
 - What are some "leaky" sources of fulfillment you've seen or experienced?
 - How does Jesus' promise in John 4:13–14 contrast with the broken cisterns of the world?
- Point #3: Recall, Remove, Repent, Return The Path Back to Awe
 - What helps you recall God's faithfulness in your life?
 - What idols might God be asking you to remove from your life right now?
 - How is true repentance different from just feeling sorry?
 - What does "returning to God" look like practically in your daily walk, and how can you apply what you've learned this week?
