Discussion Questions:

Opening Thought

- What does “being lost” look like in your spiritual life or daily decisions?
- What tools has God given us to help us find our way back when we feel lost?

God Has Plans for Where We Are — Jeremiah 29:4-10

- How does knowing God has plans for us—even in exile or hardship—change our perspective?

God Provides Deliverance from Where We Are — Daniel 1:17, Matthew 11:28

- How do you hold on to hope when deliverance feels delayed?
- What can you learn from Daniel 1:1-17 and Matthew 11:28?

God Expects an Intimate Relationship Where We Are — Jeremiah 29:12-13

- What does God’s promise of “plans to prosper you” mean in real-life struggles?
- How often do you want prosperity from God over proximity with Him?
- Why is seeking God with all your heart essential for experiencing His vision?

Final Thought: God knows where you are, and He has a plan for where you’re at

- How does the promise of a destination (eternity) and an indwelling (Holy Spirit) give you confidence today?
- What adjustments/applications will you make in your life this week based on what you’ve learned?
