  - How does understanding Jesus as God's gift change the way you see your relationship with Him?
- God's Generosity Calls For a Response (Matthew 2:1–12)
  - The Magi responded to Jesus with worship and gifts. What does this teach us about responding to God's generosity?
  - What would it look like for you to respond to God's generosity in your daily life?
- God's Generosity to the Least of These (Matthew 25:31–40)
  - Why do you think Jesus connects serving "the least of these" with serving Him?
  - How can we reflect God's generosity to those who are marginalized or in need?
- Closing Thought: God's Generosity Breaking Into Our Daily Lives (Matthew 25:14–30)
  - In the parable of the talents, what does it mean to steward what God has entrusted to us?
  - How can we avoid the fear or complacency that keeps us from using God's gifts generously?
  - What is one practical step you can take this week to let God's generosity "break through" in your life?
