**Ice Breaker:** What is the earliest memory you can remember from your life?

**Read:** Ecclesiastes 3:11; Revelation 22:13; Isaiah 44:6, 55:8-9; 1 Timothy 1:17

### Discussion Questions:

- Ecclesiastes 3:11
  - What does it mean to you that God makes everything beautiful in its time? Can you share a personal example?
  - Why do you think God has placed eternity in the human heart?
  - How do you respond when you cannot understand what God is doing from beginning to end?
- Revelation 22:13
  - How does God as “Alpha and Omega” (Beginning and End) form the way you view your past, present, and future?
  - In what ways can recognizing God as the Alpha and Omega bring peace in uncertain seasons?
- Isaiah 44:6
  - What does this verse reveal about God’s authority and uniqueness?
  - How might people today unknowingly place things “in the place of God”?
  - What does it look like to fully acknowledge God as the only true God in your decisions and priorities?
- Isaiah 55:8–9
  - Can you recall a time when God’s plan differed from yours? What did you learn?
  - Why can it be difficult for us to accept that God’s ways are higher than ours?
  - How can we grow in trusting God even when we don’t understand His plan?
- 1 Timothy 1:17
  - What stands out to you about the characteristics of God described in this verse (eternal, immortal, invisible)?
  - How does focusing on God’s eternal nature impact how we handle temporary problems?

  - How will you apply what you learned from this sermon this week?
