## A SERIES ON THE CHARACTER OF GOD

**Ice Breaker:** What is the story behind your name? Who gave it to you, and what does it mean to you today?

**Read:** Exodus 3:1-22, 4:1-5

### Discussion Questions:

- Big Question of the Sermon: What Does God Being the Great I Am Show Us?
- God's Existence (Exodus 3:1-9)
  - What stands out to you about the way God reveals Himself to Moses in the burning bush?
  - Why do you think God chose this moment and this setting to speak to Moses?
  - What does this passage teach us about God seeing and caring for the oppressed?
  - How does knowing that God is present with the marginalized challenge the way we live or serve others?
- God's Eternity (Exodus 3:10-15)
  - In Exodus 3:14, God says, "I AM WHO I AM." What do you think that means in your own words?
  - What does God revealing His own name (instead of receiving one from others) tell us about His nature?
- God's Empowerment (Exodus 3:16-20)
  - God calls Moses, even though Moses feels unqualified. Why do you think God uses imperfect people?
  - What does this passage show us about where true power comes from?
  - Where in your life is God calling you to trust His power instead of your limitations?
- Closing Thoughts: God's Engagement (Exodus 4:1-5)
  - How does God being the Great I AM help you better understand who God is and who you really are?
  - Are there any false names or labels you've carried that God may be asking you to release?
  - When we encounter God, we are also given a new identity—beloved, redeemed, reconciled, and sent. Which of these resonates most with you right now, and why?
  - Is there a next step of obedience you feel God is calling you to do? How will you respond this week?
