Ice Breaker: If you could instantly become an expert in any subject, what would it be and why?

Read: Psalm 139:1-4; Matthew 7:21-23, Matthew 14:22-33; Genesis 3

Discussion Questions:

- Opening Thought
 - Can you think of a time when God provided something for you before you even knew you needed it?
- God Knows All (Psalm 139:1-4)
 - How does it feel to know God is aware of every detail of your life — your thoughts, words, and actions?
 - If you truly believe God sees every scene of your life, how should that shape the way you live today?
 - Why do you think we sometimes live as if God doesn't see or know everything?
 - Is there anything in your life you wish God didn't know about? Why?
- God Wants to Know You (Matthew 7:21–23; Genesis 3)
 - What's the difference between knowing about God and actually knowing God?
 - Why do you think people can do “religious” things and still not truly know Him?
 - What masks or “robes” do people often wear to appear spiritually okay?
 - In Genesis 3, Adam and Eve hid from God — what are some ways we still try to hide today?
 - Have you ever experienced a moment where your faith became real (beyond just knowledge)? What changed?
- God Knew Now (Matthew 14:22–33)
 - Why do you think Peter was able to walk on water at first but then began to sink?
 - What “storms” in your life tend to take your focus off Jesus?
 - How does knowing God already saw your struggles before they happened change your trust in Him?
- Closing Thought
 - What is one step you can take this week to stop hiding and start walking with God honestly and intentionally?
