Ice Breaker: If you were to assemble a team of superheroes, who would be your top 3 choices, why?

Read: Exodus 14:14, Exodus 1:8–14, Exodus 3:7–8, Exodus 6:1, Psalm 91:1–4, Isaiah 26:3, Jeremiah 29:12–14, Acts 16:22–31, and Acts 16:26–34

Discussion Questions:

- Opening Thoughts
 - Who from the people you know would you choose to fight on your behalf in a:
 - Physical fight? Mental fight? Spiritual fight?
- The Physical Fight (Exodus 1:8–14, Exodus 3:7–8, Exodus 6:1, Psalm 91:1–4)
 - What do these passages reveal about how God responds to the suffering of His people?
 - In Exodus 3:7–8, what specific actions does God say He will take on behalf of Israel?
 - How does Psalm 91 describe God's protection?
 - Have you ever faced a situation where it seemed like opposition increased when you were trying to follow God?
 - What does it look like to remain faithful while waiting for God to fight on your behalf?
- The Mental Fight (Isaiah 26:3, Jeremiah 29:12–14, Acts 16:22–31)
 - According to Isaiah 26:3, what is connected to experiencing God's perfect peace?
 - What promises does God make in Jeremiah 29:12–14 regarding those who seek Him?
 - How did Paul and Silas respond after being beaten and imprisoned, and what happened as a result of their worship and prayers?
 - Which of these battles have you struggled with most: fear, shame, anxiety, lies, self-doubt, or condemnation?
 - Why do you think mental and emotional battles can sometimes feel more exhausting than physical ones?
 - What practical habits help you keep your mind focused on God?
- The Spiritual Fight (Acts 16:26–34)
 - What spiritual transformation took place in the jailer and his household?
 - What role did Paul and Silas play in leading the jailer to salvation?
 - How does this story demonstrate God's power to save?
 - Why do you think the enemy targets people's souls?
 - How can spiritual battles sometimes disguise themselves as physical or emotional struggles?
 - What difference does it make to know that Christ has already won the ultimate victory?

 - What's your biggest takeaway from this study and how will you apply what you've learned this week?
