Discussion Questions:

- Opening Thoughts
 - Do you tend to remember the difficult moments of your life, or the daily faithfulness of God? Why?
- Remember His Faithfulness (Deuteronomy 8:2-5)
 - What does Moses tell the Israelites to remember?
 - Why was it important for Israel to remember their wilderness experience?
 - What lessons did God teach His people during those forty years?
 - How can difficult seasons reveal what's truly in our hearts?
 - Pastor Tyronne mentioned how "prosperity without remembrance eventually produces pride." Have you ever experienced a season where blessings caused you to become less dependent on God? What happened?
- Recognize Him in Every Season (Deuteronomy 8:3-6)
 - Why do we sometimes struggle to recognize God's hand at work in our lives?
 - How did God provide for Israel in unexpected ways?
 - What are some ways God provides that are not always material or financial?
 - Have there been times when God answered your needs differently than you expected? How can unmet expectations become obstacles to gratitude?
 - What blessings might you be overlooking because they do not match your expectations?
- Live from His Faithfulness (Deuteronomy 8:7-18)
 - What blessings does Moses describe that Israel would experience in the Promised Land?
 - What warning does Moses give after the people experience abundance? Why is this important?
