Acts 4:31-37; Acts 5:1-11; 2 Corinthians 9:6-12

1. Bold prayers.
2. Powerful testimonies.
3. Christ-centered unity.
4. Radical generosity.
5. Extreme integrity.

SMALL GROUP MEETING OUTLINE

Where your faith intersects with real life!

Reconnect:

Each person shares a recent high and low from their life.

Explore:

Review the message notes.

Big Idea: God's Spirit moves in people to reveal Jesus and advance His kingdom.

Consider:

Choose one or two questions for your Group to discuss as time allows.

- Read Acts 4:31-37. Pastor Matt shared that bold prayer starts with repentance and asking for courage in the face of opposition. Share about a recent time when you have prayed a bold prayer.
- Take a few moments to reflect on your testimony. Write it down in a sentence and share it with your group.
- Pastor Matt said that we don't drift into unity. Active unity often looks like sacrifice. Share about a time when you have chosen unity over your personal preference.

Activate:

Spend a moment in silence to consider your response, then share with the Group.

Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-12. This passage includes "For God loves a person who gives cheerfully. And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need, and plenty left over to share with others." Have you experienced God's generosity?

Prayer:

Thank God for the highs and lift up the lows.

"Lord, may your Spirit move in our kids and teenagers to be a generous people. May our generation show them by example. And may your kingdom come and your will be done on earth as it is in Heaven."
