
SERVE WITH CV SEEDS ESL CLASSES

Revelation 2:12-17, Revelation 1:16, Matthew 10:32-34, Hebrews 4:12-13, Matthew 24:4-5,11, 2 Corinthians 11:3 NIV, 2 Timothy 4:3-4, Romans 12:2

Three things Jesus reveals as the one with the two-edged sword in his mouth:

- 1. His word is the standard of truth.
- His word <u>confronts</u> tolerating false teaching.
- 3. His word aligns our identity with Him.

Reconnect:

Each person shares a recent high and low from their life.

Explore:

Review the message notes.

Big Idea: Jesus prepares His church to guard against spiritual deception by confronting false teaching with the authority of His word.

Consider:

Choose one or two questions for your Group to discuss as time allows.

- 1. Read Hebrews 4:12-13. As you read this verse and think about the authority of God's word, what are your thoughts about every thought being exposed, even our innermost thoughts and desires?
- 2. Read Matthew 10:32-34. Pastor Matt said, "Being a faithful witness means to hold fast to the truth in enemy territory, which protects from the deception of false teaching." What does 'holding fast' to the truth look like for you?
- 3. Read Matthew 24:4–5, 11; 2 Corinthians 11:3–4; and Romans 12:2. How can we guard against false teaching?

Activate:

Spend a moment in silence to consider your response, then share with the Group.

Which of these steps is He prompting you to take this week?

- Be a student of God's word
- Examine your starting assumptions
- Check your influences
- Invite accountability

Prayer:

Thank God for the highs and lift up the lows.

Lord, help us to pay attention to your words. Examine our hearts, check our influencers, and invite accountability.
