After much prayer, and the generosity and faith of many, Medford Nazarene moves forward in faith during a recession to build a new building which would later be known as the McAndrews campus.




1955

LOCAL & GLOBAL MISSION IN A PANDEMIC



- Provided emergency shelter, thousands of relief items and \$26,500 in gift cards for fire survivors.
- Housed and fed hundreds of Samaritans Purse volunteers who worked at 555 homesites.
- Started a fire relief grant which gave away \$27,000 to survivors.

REACHING OUR WORLD

- Sent out and resourced 1 family as mission partners in the Eastern Mediterranean field.
- Sent 2 church planters and over \$150,000 in resources to plant 2 new churches in Florida.
- Gave away \$87,800 to various mission partners through the Christmas Offering and Holiday Bazaar.

LOVING OUR CITY

- City Care 2021: Blessed local and global partners with work projects.
 Made appreciation boxes and wrote one thousand thank you cards for healthcare workers.
- City Care 2022: Partnered with Roosevelt School to put on a carnival for 700 people. Worked at 25 homes in our neighborhood. Blessed local and global partners. Wrote five hundred thank you cards to Medford Police and Fire Departments.



- 160 people made first-time decisions to follow Jesus.
- 67 declared their faith through baptism.

OUR GOAL: Increase and fully fund our mission budget for 2 years.

We will invest in ministry to visitors by updating our Worship Center exterior, interior lobbies, and sanctuary to create spaces that help them feel welcomed and cared for. We will reduce our debt to free up resources to invest back into ministries that help every person know God, know people, and make a difference!

OUR GOAL: Establish a Leadership Residency and start a fund for future locations of New Life.

OUR WHY: The Kingdom of God is bigger than one building in one city. We want to bring hope to the entire Rogue Valley. Our Leadership Residency will help us draw in and raise up new leaders to start New Life ministries and locations in or near every community in the valley.
















OUR COMMITMENT CARD
