## Discussion and Reflection Questions Trinity Sunday - 4<sup>th</sup> of June 2023

## Read: Matthew 28.16-20

<sup>16</sup> Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. <sup>17</sup> When they saw him, they worshipped him; but some doubted. <sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and said to them, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.'

## **Discussion Questions**

- 1. Is there a 'member' of the Holy Spirit that you connect/understand best? Is there one you find hardest to comprehend?
- 2. Have you ever had to try & explain God to someone (who was genuinely interested)? How did it go?
- 3. How many people in your "every-day life" are significantly different to you? How can that be helpful & how can it be challenging?
- 4. Acts 2:42 says the early church was devoted... on a scale of 1-10 how devoted do you think you are? What helps & hinders devotion to the things mentioned in this verse.
- 5. What does it mean to Co-Mission with God?
- 6. How does it make you feel that Jesus has promised to always be with us?
- 7. We are instructed to "Go therefore" where & how do we go?
