## Discussion and.Reflection Questions Grief for the benefit of others - All Saints Day 5th of November 2023

## Read: Matthew 5.1-12

¹ When Jesus saw the crowds, he went up the mountain; and after he sat down, his disciples came to him. ² Then he began to speak, and taught them, saying: ³ 'Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. ⁴ 'Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted. ⁵ 'Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth. ⁶ 'Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled. ⁵ 'Blessed are the merciful, for they will receive mercy. ⁵ 'Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God. ⁵ 'Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God. ¹o 'Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. ¹¹ 'Blessed are you when people revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. ¹² Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

- 1. How do you think the first hearers of the Sermon on the Mount would have received Jesus' teaching (known as the Beatitudes)?
- 2. What does it mean to be blessed? Do you have a working definition of "blessed"?
- 3. How would you define mounting & grief? What is your experience of mourning?
- 4. How does grief impact life other than when people we know die?
- 5. Have you seen or experienced any cultural differences in grief, particularly public grief?
- 6. How can grief be for the benefit of others?
- 7. Can mourning become a spiritual discipline?
