## Discussion and Reflection Questions Baptism of Our Lord 7th of January 2024

## Reading: Mark 1:4-11

<sup>4</sup> John the baptiser appeared in the wilderness, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. <sup>5</sup> And people from the whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem were going out to him, and were baptised by him in the river Jordan, confessing their sins. <sup>6</sup> Now John was clothed with camel's hair, with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey. <sup>7</sup> He proclaimed, 'The one who is more powerful than I is coming after me; I am not worthy to stoop down and untie the thong of his sandals. <sup>8</sup> I have baptised you with water; but he will baptise you with the Holy Spirit.' <sup>9</sup> In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptised by John in the Jordan. <sup>10</sup> And just as he was coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens torn apart and the Spirit descending like a dove on him. <sup>11</sup> And a voice came from heaven, 'You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased.'

- 1) What has been your experience of baptism? Baptism can occur in different ways for different people & different churches, what impact has baptism had in your journey?
- 2) What do you think it means for us that Jesus was baptised?
- 3) What is your own experience of repentance & forgiveness?
- 4) Do you find it easier to repent or to forgive others?
- 5) How do you deal with new beginnings & change?
- 6) How do you see & experience the move of the Holy Spirit in your life, in the Church & in others?
