Youth Group



Our Sunday Night Youth Group program is for both middle and high school students. We begin with dinner, \$6 each, and spend time playing on purpose as we grow in our faith and discipleship. Campfire Theology



Grab your camping chair and blanket and join us in the Dover parking lot for a laid back and casual evening around the campfire. From life application to current events, we discuss the intersection of our faith and our lives. The chill atmosphere makes this an easy event for high schoolers to show up as they are. Middle School Small Groups

Middle School Leadership Team

High School Leadership Team



The High School Leadership Team (HSLT) is a team of 9th-12th graders who meet weekly on Zoom to plan youth group events, youth retreats, learn leadership skills and help facilitate youth events. Our HSLT focuses on leadership development in the areas of public speaking, writing prayers or liturgy, programming, empowering the gifts of others and practicing radical hospitality.

Being a youth adviser for WMPC Youth not only involves large group program assistance, leading small groups and facilitating discussions, but also playing a vital role in welcoming students and loving them exactly where they are. 

Appalachia Service Project (ASP)



June 11 - 17, 2023 Cost: \$400, \$150 deposit Completed 9th - 12th grade

Appalachian Service Project (ASP), has a rich history with White Memorial! We've been sending mission teams with ASP for 30 years! This amazing mission trip provides one of the most rewarding structured service opportunities in the nation, bringing thousands of volunteers from around the country to rural Central Appalachia to repair homes for low-income families.

Chiapas Mexico International Mission Trip



July 01 - 09, 2023 Cost: \$950, \$150 deposit Completed 10th - 12th grade

We will spend eight nights in the Chiapas region of Mexico working with a faith-based humanitarian nonprofit organization, Hebron USA ,Hebrón de Desarrollo Tzeltal. The trip will include construction projects, cultural engagement opportunities, providing Vacation Bible School and time to experience Mexico as a tourist. This short-term, international trip is an incredible experience for those who want to get their hands dirty serving and partnering with God's people in Chiapas. No experience or training necessary – just an open heart and a willing spirit!

REGISTRATION PROCESS FOR SUMMER TRIPS

Fall Registration Period - Sept. 12, 2022 to Oct. 10, 2022

- Only active participants or church members may register during the Fall Registration Period.
- This is not first-come, first-served. All who register online between these dates will have equal opportunity of securing a spot.
- Adults will be invited to participate as summer trip leaders during this period.
- The number of spots confirmed will be dependent upon the availability of registrations by the particular ministry site, transportation availability, and the size of the leadership team.

What happens if there are more registrants than available spots on a particular trip?

Preference will be given in the following order: has a family member serving in a leadership role on the trip, youth is in their last year of eligibility for a particular trip, those who are regularly active in the life of WMPC, and then all others. Within those groups, a random drawing will be utilized.

Confirmation emails will be sent Monday Oct. 17, 2022.

The registrant has 10 working days (Friday, October 28, 2022) to submit payment and all appropriate paperwork. Failure to do so will result in loss of a spot and the registrant will have to re-register.

REGISTRATION PROCESS FOR SUMMER TRIPS

Winter Registration Period - Jan. 09, 2023 to Feb. 13, 2023

- There is no guarantee that all trips will have spots available during this registration period.
- Adults will be invited to participate as summer trip leaders during this period.
- Any youth, including guests and visitors may register during the winter registration period.
- Preference will be the same as the Fall Registration Period.

Open Registration Period - Feb. 27,2023 until all spots are filled

Beginning Feb 28, 2023 all remaining spots will be filled on a first come, first served basis.

Bob Ames Scholarship

Robert G. Ames Youth Ministry Fund was established in 1996 by the estate of Bob Ames, a former director of Youth Ministry, to benefit the youth ministry of White Memorial Presbyterian Church. The funds provide financial assistance to youth active in the church's youth ministry for mission trips, conferences, retreats and other church sponsored events.

One goal of the scholarship supported by this fund is to ensure that no youth is unable to participant in any church function due to financial considerations.
