

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

As your kid starts their day, point out a way you've seen them grow and mature in the past few months.



Meal Time

At a meal, have everyone at the table answer this question: "Have you ever felt stuck—wanting something different to happen but nothing seems to change?"



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your kid: "What are some things that we see every day that can help us remember God is always with us?" (Give some examples—the kindness of people, the way we care for each other, a new day, etc.)



Bed Time

Pray for each other: "God, You know more than we do, and You know how things are going to turn out—even if it takes more time than we hoped. Help us to remember that when we feel stuck or discouraged."
