For Small Group discussion & application this week:

Based on your personal time in Hebrews 3:1-6 this week, what did God teach you?

Share a specific time in your life that you persevered in your relationship with Christ and experienced victory and growth.

Do you have a passion for the mission to lead others to Jesus? How does that help you persevere? How might that passion need to grow? What specific steps do you need to take? How can others in your Small Group practically help?

What truth stood out to you from the message that you didn't get on your own? Why is that particular truth significant to you at this time and how will you apply it to your life?

Looking ahead: for next Sunday, February 13, take a closer look at Hebrews 3:7-19.

As you read the text, make note of key words that stand out to you. Examine those further.

Summarize Hebrews 3:7–11 in terms of cause (see 3:8–9) and effect (see 3:10–11).

What is the connection between sin and unbelief (see 3:12–13)? How does 3:16–19 provide a concrete example of this connection?

In view of the seriousness of the warning in 3:7–12, why is it so important to encourage one another daily (see 3:13)? What might happen if we fail to encourage one another?

If a person has come to “share in Christ” (3:14), what outward evidence will he or she show?

“Today” is repeated (3:7, 13, 15), what point is the author making? Why do you think this emphasis on “Today” is so important?

What one sin, promise, example, command, or truth about God would you like to concentrate on for application this week?
