For Small Group discussion & application this week:

Based on your personal time in Hebrews 13:1-3 this week, what did God teach you? Were there specific words, phrases or truths that stood out to you?

Do you enjoy God fully by spending time with Him and listening to Him as He speaks to you through His word and His Spirit? Are you careful to properly interpret scripture? How does your process impact your application?

Are you caught in the doing vs. being trap? How can this idea either trip you up, or free to live as God intends?

Where & how are you experiencing specific spiritual growth in your life?

What truth stood out to you from the message that you didn't get on your own? Why is that significant to you at this time and how can you act on that this week?

Looking ahead: for next Sunday, June 12, take a close look at Hebrews 13:4.

This week we take a very close look at one verse with great impact. Draw near to God asking Him to reveal truth to you.

Why is it so important to honor marriage and keep the marriage bed "undefiled" (pure)? Examine closer the word "undefiled" (or pure). What does that word mean? How is this command played out in today's culture?

Take time this week to also look at 1 Corinthians 6:12–20 and Ephesians 5:25–32.

Read 12:1, 14. How is this instruction lived out practically in the command of verse 4?
