For Small Group discussion & application this week:

Let's be honest, this passage gets into some very personal, intimate parts of our lives. Find someone that you can talk with, to be honest enough to open up about the hard stuff you may be dealing with. Hebrews 3:13 taught us about this kind of daily encouragement so as not to be deceived by sin.

Be sensitive to the needs of others as you meet. This may be a time that you get even smaller in your group discussions to allow for vulnerability and transparency, while maintaining the integrity of your time together.

Based on your personal time in Hebrews 13:4 this week, what did God teach you?

Are there areas of your life that you are allowing vulnerability to sin that may be compromising the purity of your view on sex as God designed?

Are there areas that you need to confess or experience healing? Maybe addiction or control that will give you a godly perspective on love, sex, relationships and marriage?

What truth stood out to you from the message that you didn't get on your own? Why is that significant to you at this time and how can you act on that this week?

Looking ahead: for next Sunday, June 19, take a closer look at Hebrews 13:5-6.

As you study these verses this week, draw near to God asking Him to reveal truth to you. They may seem simple, yet there is great depth in understanding and application.
