Looking ahead to Sunday, May 11.

Use the Southbridge Journaling method to examine Galatians 2:1-10. As you read the passage, simply ask and answer the questions about the text for that day. (there is also a video link teaching this method in the 4-Week Disciple-Making Starter Guide)

SAY - What does it say? What stands out to me as I read? is there a word that caught my attention?

OBSERVE - What do I observe in the passage? How does it fit the theme of Paul's letter or the idea of the verses around it?

UNDERSTAND - What do I understand or not understand? Are there words I need to define?

TRUTH - What truth is taught? Is there a command, promise, prayer, example or caution?

HOW - What is God saying to me personally and how I am supposed to grow because of this truth?
