

40 Days of Spiritual Preparation

Feb 22 First Things First. Today we embark on a personal journey with God. Take time to reflect on pursuing God first and above all else these next 40 days. (Matthew 6:33)

Feb 23 Obedience to God's Word. Ask the Holy Spirit today for help with obeying God's Word in an area that has been hard for you to follow through. (1 John 5:3)

Feb 24 Forgiveness. Strengthen your relationship with God today by forgiving someone who hurt you. Extend grace to them as Christ has done for us. (Colossians 3:13)

Feb 25 Attend Church Regularly. We are called to live in Biblical community with one another, worshipping with one spirit, hearing from God's Word, and serving one another. (Acts 2:42-47)

Feb 26 Sunday Service. Join us for worship!

Feb 27 Priority of Prayer. Make prayer a priority today; it is powerful and effective. (James 5:16)

Feb 28 World Events. Think how the recent staggering world events might be used as an open door to speak about spiritual and eternal things with people who do not know Jesus.

Mar 1 Neighborly Peace. Pray peace over a difficult neighbor. Seek harmony where God has placed you to live. (Leviticus 19:18)

Mar 2 Contentment. Choose to be satisfied with God's management of your life and praise Him for knowing what is best. (Philippians 4:11)

Mar 3 Mercy. Who can you empathize with today? Be a safe space for someone needing a shoulder, comfort, or prayer.
(2 Corinthians 1:3-5)

Mar 4 Enable KCC Youth. Investing in our youth and their walk with the Lord is necessary in growing the body of Christ. Let's encourage them so they stay true to God for the rest of their lives.

Mar 5 Sunday Service. Join us for worship!

Mar 6 Intentional Encounters. Be purposeful with your conversations with people encountered at retail places, restaurants, etc. knowing God is seeking everyone to know Him. (Colossians 4:5)

Mar 7 Thought Inventory. Ask God to reveal how He views your thoughts. Ask Him to change any harmful thought patterns. (2 Corinthians 10:5)

Mar 8 Give Up Control. Accept God's sovereignty in your life and lean into it. (Prov 3:5)

Mar 9 Draw Near. On days of pain, depression, overworked, and disappointment, God invites us to draw near to Him that we might experience His peace, healing, and closeness. (Psalm 34:18)

Mar 10 Identity In Christ. Recognize it is Christ who defines us, not any other source (work, school, talent). (Philippians 3:8)

Mar 11 Leave a Legacy. Consider leaving a written legacy of what God has done in your life for future generations. (Psalm 145:3-7)

Mar 12 Sunday Service. Join us for worship!

Mar 13 Time Management. Seek God's help in handling His gift of time more wisely and efficiently. (Psalm 90:12)

- Mar 14 Abiding in God's Word. Be deliberate about setting time aside to remain in God's Word. It is not optional for the believer we can do nothing apart from the Vine. (John 15:4)
- Mar 15 Doing Your Part. God is at work to draw people to Himself. Perhaps you are the sower, perhaps the reaper. Consider how He is using you to accomplish His will as you interact with the people around you today. (John 4:31-45)
- **Mar 16** Patience. Invite the Holy Spirit's help today with frustrating and difficult situations. (Exodus 34:6)
- Mar 17 Exercise Your Spiritual Gifts. Spiritual gifts edify and mature the church and glorify God in serving others. (1 Peter 4:10-11)
- **Mar 18** Hospitality. Establish a welcoming space for people to gather and for the gospel to grow. (Romans 10:17)
- Mar 19 Sunday Service. Join us for worship!
- **Mar 20** All Things New. Spring reminds us that God makes all things new. Therefore, press on to acknowledge Him who restores and refreshes. (Hosea 6:3, 1 Peter 5:10)
- Mar 21 Pray For Those In Authority. God's Word says to pray for those who are over us in authority so that we may live in peace. Ask a manager, boss, teacher, or leader if you can pray with them for a need they have. (1 Timothy 2:1-2)
- Mar 22 Group Prayer. Praying in groups reminds us we are part of God's church, unity in the spirit, and heard as one. There are a few opportunities in our church to pray together weekly, bi-weekly, monthly, even daily. Consider attending a group and experience the blessings God has in store for us. (Ephesians 3:20)
- Mar 23 Entrust. Be encouraged to trust the Lord when you have been hurt by someone. (1 Peter 2:23)
- **Mar 24** Grateful for Encouragement. Let others know the ways they have encouraged you. (Philemon 1:4-7)
- **Mar 25** Repentance. Through prayer and God's forgiveness, commit to a change of mind leading to a change of action. (1 John 1:8-9)
- Mar 26 Sunday Service. Join us for worship!

- Mar 27 Love the Unlovable. Only God can help us to love the unlovely. Demonstrate your identity with Christ today by loving a difficult person. (John 13:35).
- Mar 28 Teachable Spirit. Absorb what you learn of God and be quick to turn your steps to His ways. (Psalm 119:56-60)
- Mar 29 Write Your Story. Think through what God has done in your life and write out your testimony to share with others. (Psalm 107:2)
- **Mar 30** Willing to Sacrifice. Be willing to give to God something most valuable to you (perhaps time, money, or energy) for His glory. (1 Peter 2:5)
- Mar 31 Unity. Living and serving in unity is good and pleasant and results in God's blessings. (Psalm 133:1-3)
- **Apr 1** Humility. Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves. (Philippians 2:3)
- Apr 2 Sunday Service. Join us for worship!
- **Apr 3** Hope. Easter brings a message of hope: reconciliation and forgiveness of sins through Jesus' endurance of the cross. How can you thank Him today for His sacrifice?
- **Apr 4** Easter Invitations. Ask God to arrange divine opportunities for you to invite someone to church on Easter God is already preparing the hearts of those people longing to be included.
- **Apr 5** Be a Friend. Who can you come along side today to help carry their burden? Not because you are forced, but because you can. (Matthew 27:32)
- **Apr 6** Consider the Cross. It is finished. All that separates us from God was placed on Jesus that day, and He did it for us. Who in your circle of influence needs to hear this message of love? (John 19:30)
- **Apr 7** Waiting. Life can seem like a constant state of waiting for the Lord. But we wait and trust in His promises. (Deuteronomy 31:8)
- **Apr 8** Hearts of Thankfulness. He loved us so much that He gave His only Son to die for us! Today and every day walk in grace and tell this good news to the world! (John 3:16)
