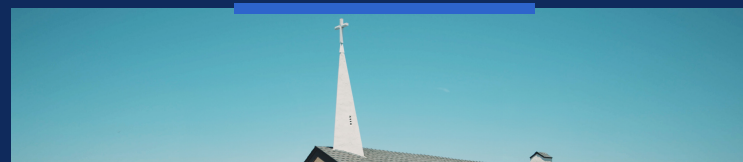

We value choosing radical generosity. That means giving time, talents, and treasures back to the Lord. Because of the radical generosity of our church body, we have been able to scholarship mission trips, missionaries, church planters, adoptions, city projects, gifts to those in need, and catalyze numerous other gospel opportunities.

We Invest to Send



When we participate in mission trips—whether for a week, a month, or a year—we contribute to the transformative work of the gospel in other parts of the world. Our goal is to make mission trips accessible to everyone. Thanks to the radical generosity of our community, we are able to subsidize these trips in the following ways:

SHORT-TERM (1 – 2 WEEKS) SCHOLARSHIPS

Up to a 25% scholarship for any Fielder adult covenant member.

Up to a 50% scholarship for Fielder children, students, and college undergraduates.

These scholarships are applied after fundraising to any covenant member going on a Fielder sponsored mission trip.

MID-TERM (3 WEEKS – 1 YEAR) SCHOLARSHIPS

Up to a 25% scholarship, limited to \$5,000, for most mid-term opportunities outside Fielder partnerships after fundraising.

Up to a 50% scholarship, limited to \$5,000, for Fielder-specific partners after fundraising.

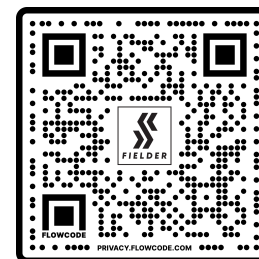
LONG-TERM (1 YEAR+) GRANTS

For Fielder covenant members sent out as long-term mission expanders, ministry support will be assessed on a case-by-case basis. This may include ongoing ministry funding, moving expenses, graphic or media expenses, etc.

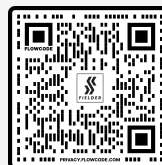

WHY WE SEND STUDENTS

If we are intentional with our students, we can create a powerful opportunity to train and deploy some of the most well-prepared missionaries, church planters, and mission expanders. We have established key milestones to equip and mentor students, helping them to grasp the significance of contextualized church planting. Each mission trip is designed as a transformative step in an ongoing journey that fosters a deeper desire to obey God's command to make disciples of all nations.

These trips are thoughtfully designed to challenge students at every grade level, building a strong foundation in missional readiness so that serving in different settings becomes second nature. This diverse exposure helps students discern their unique role in God's mission.

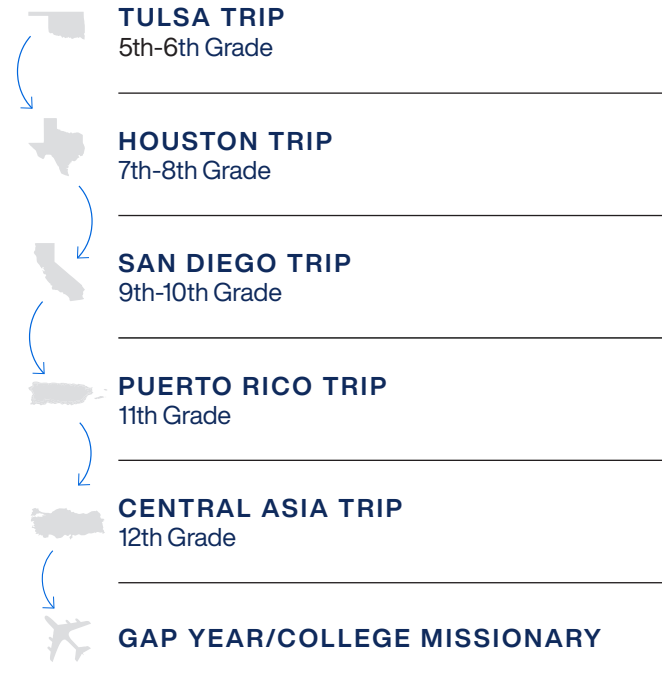
Through this process, we aim to cultivate a mindset that prioritizes mission over mascot—where students consider their steps after high school by choosing to be a part of a movement. It could mean taking a gap year for intensive discipleship, choosing a college based on the church planting movement in the area, or dedicating their college summers to serving in different contexts, learning firsthand from missionaries and planters what it takes to reach the lost

COLLEGE & YOUNG ADULT TRIPS

MESA CHURCH - SAN DIEGO

What: This is a vision trip to come alongside Charlie Houck at Mesa Church. The team will learn about church planting, serving within the community, and prayer walk a college campus to consider serving with Mesa Church mid-term in the summer.

MOSAIC CHURCH - UTAH

What: In Utah, we will partner with Mosaic Church to share the gospel in the least gospel-reached city in the United States. The greater Salt Lake City area is home to about 2.8 million people, with the vast majority having never heard the gospel and are desperately looking for the hope and assurance Jesus offers.

WAYS TO SERVE

SERVE KIDS

Trinity Kids, an all-volunteer organization, supports children navigating foster care by hosting Royal Family Kids Camp, holding events, and advocating for family preservation.

Adopting a School allows community groups to volunteer and provide much needed support to local schools with limited resources.

Serve the Food Insecure through Children's Hunger Fund Delivery, Arlington Charities, and other distribution avenues to local children facing food insecurity.

Kids Hope USA allows us to mentor K-6 students weekly through nine local elementary school partnerships.

SERVE FAMILIES

Wrap Around a Foster or Adoptive Family to support these families facing unique challenges by providing community, connection, and both physical and spiritual care.

Care Portal is a partnership with churches and the city of Grand Prairie to address the physical and spiritual needs of those at risk or already in the child welfare system.

Families Count supports parents with children in or at-risk of entering the foster care system with Christ-centered parenting classes, mentoring, and church connections.

Metroplex Women's Clinic offers free health services for unplanned pregnancies, with volunteer opportunities such as hosting baby showers or working in their resale shop.

Embrace Grace provides support and community through local churches for single and pregnant young women and their families.

SERVE OUR COMMUNITY AND NEIGHBORS

International Student Inc. shares Christ with international students and offers volunteer opportunities like hosting home groups or joining Friday night activities.

Mission Arlington shares Jesus through their apartment churches and relief ministries. Partner with an apartment church as they minister to their community.

Spread the Love Ministry shares Christ with the homeless through monthly BBQs and weekly Bible studies.

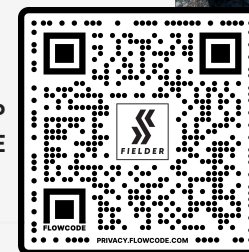
Local Cross-Cultural Ministry partners with 2-3 evangelical missions organizations to mobilize prayer and missionaries for unreached DFW communities, offering training and outreach to share the gospel.

Christian Women's Job Corp equips women with job skills and Christian community to be able to enter and be supported in the workforce.

Bridges to Life connects communities to prisons, ministering to victims and offenders to show God's love and forgiveness.

We live in a broken world in need of redemption. Although we can't solve every problem or meet every need, we can stand in the gap to help care for the most vulnerable in our community. We support, shepherd, and equip individuals and families to exhale the gospel as they respond in a variety of ways, such as mentoring a child through Kids Hope, fostering, adopting, ministering to birth families, and helping preserve families through the hope we have in Christ.

Kids Hope Ministry

Mentoring makes a big difference in the life of an at-risk child. We partner with Kids Hope USA, which gives us a platform to mentor children in our local schools. As the body of Christ, we understand what it means to be faithful, caring, and share unconditional love. Through the power of relationships, we see these children build resilience and confidence!

ONE CHILD. ONE HOUR.

Kids Hope USA mentors spend just one hour per week, reading, talking, playing, and listening to a child at school. We know that God has called our church to invest in kids' lives in a significant way through this mentoring program.

We are currently in 9 local schools with 200+ mentors, with many kids still waiting for a mentor.

Foster Care & Adoption Ministry



The Fielder Foster Care & Adoption Ministry exists to lead, shepherd, and equip our members to exhale the gospel by relieving children through foster care & adoption.

As followers of Christ, we are compelled by the gospel to pursue and care for orphans and vulnerable children both in our city and around the world.

As a church, we want to help families walk in obedience to the calling God has placed on them. We aim to connect families interested in adoption & foster care with trusted local agencies, and to provide support and discipleship throughout their journey.

While many of us will bring children into our homes, the rest of us are going to find ways to serve and support them. Everybody can do something!

Family Preservation

What if the church stepped in before children entered foster care? What if we helped restore families that have been torn apart? What if we walked alongside those facing unexpected pregnancies—equipping them and reminding them they are not alone?

The Family Preservation Ministry exists to do just that. We support families at risk of having their children removed from their homes and help reunite families who have already experienced separation. This ministry helps with biological family preservation or reunification by presenting opportunities to hear the gospel and connect with a discipling church community.

Here's how you can get involved in Family Preservation Ministry:

FAMILIES COUNT

Families Count is a family restoration and preservation ministry supporting parents with children in or at-risk of entering foster care. Through seven weeks of Christ-centered parenting classes and one-on-one mentorship, this class equips birth families with practical and spiritual tools for stability through the local church.

EMBRACE GRACE

Embrace Grace is a 12-week support group for women with unexpected pregnancies. Through dynamic teachings and personal testimonies from women who have walked in their shoes, this biblically based curriculum introduces young mothers to Jesus and focuses on their identity and worth in Him. As attendees experience the love of God through His people, they are connected to a spiritual family through the church.



God's plan for redeeming humanity is being fulfilled through the church. We expose the church to God's heart for His people, guide them to engage the lost around us, and equip the church to expand the mission of God in other places. This is why we intentionally send mission expanders to plant churches from DFW to the ends of the earth.



Mid or Long-Term

God's only plan for the redemption of humanity is the church. There is no "plan B." We have a goal that we will have sent out more than 1,400 of our people to plant churches or expand the mission of God in other places and to have 100 of our people serving as global missionaries around the world. Join us in this effort by going for a summer, semester, 1-2 years or longer nationally or internationally to learn from church planters and see what life might look like to join them in the expansion of the mission of God in other places.

Mid-Term

3 WEEKS – 1 YEAR

We send mid-term workers to come alongside our long-term workers to learn from them, join in on their work, provide a fresh perspective, and encourage them. Mid-term options are helpful for those exploring a call to go or have a chance to serve the Lord for a summer or semester. We want to help our church members have missional experiences so that they might understand God that much better.

We partner with organizations in North America and around the world to send high school seniors, college students, and adults on trips that span over a summer, semester, or anything in between. Our partners in San Diego, Central Asia, Southeast Asia, Houston, and New York City are all looking for believers who are willing to step out in faith and join them.

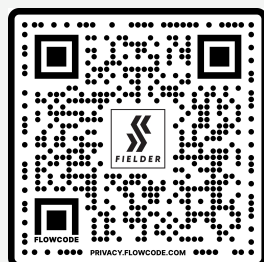

GO 2

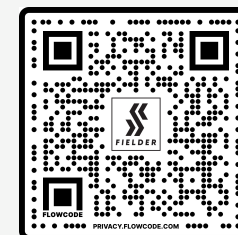
Spend the first two years after college as a part of a church planting team in North America or around the globe. Ages 21-30.

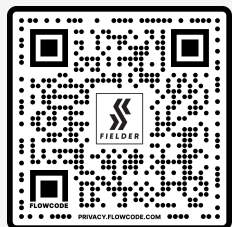

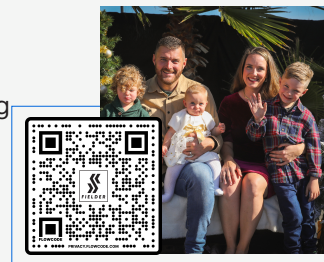

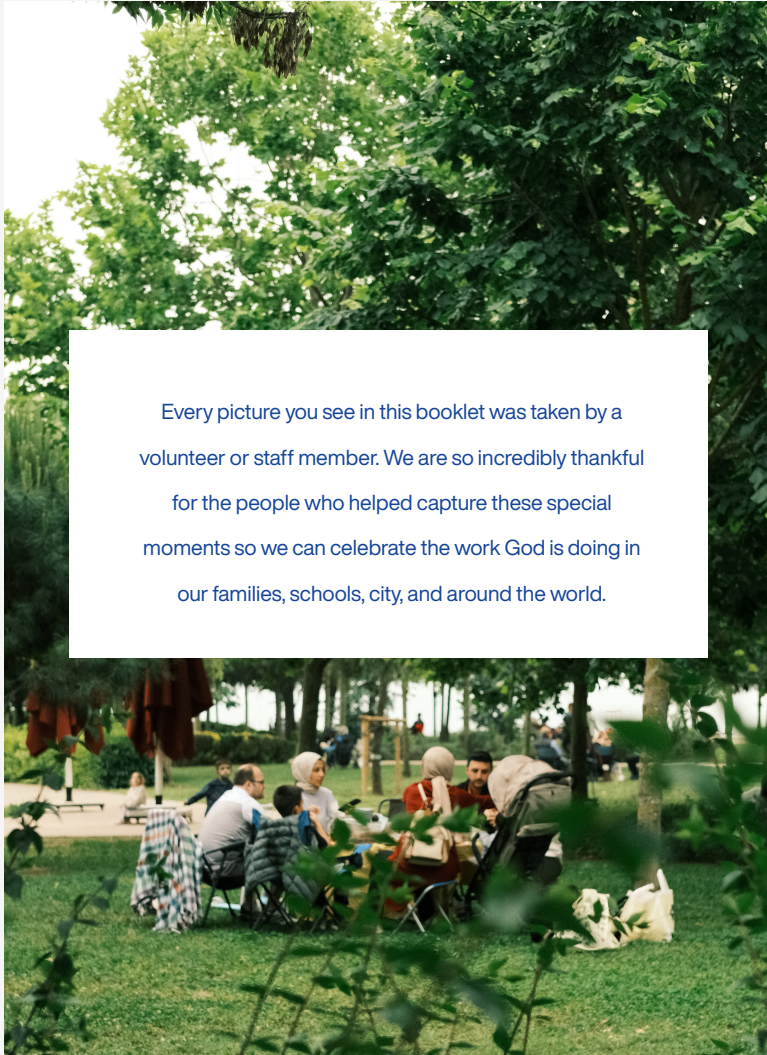
Fielder Church pastors and staff will invest in these future mission expanders by equipping them through learning cohorts, hands-on ministry, leadership development, and missional experience.
