LOCAL IMPACT

Goal: To reach the poor, hopeless, and people in need through the local church.



Through our partnership with **DEFIANCE DREAM CENTER:**

- 198 students graduated Ignite Academy, going through the Mission Portrait program, empowering them with purpose and direction in their lives.
- 26 at-risk juniors and seniors in high school graduated the Workforce Development program, equipped with skilled trades and life-skills needed for their future plans.
- 154 vehicles were repaired for single mom's, widows, veteran spouses
- 20 fathers went through the 24/7 Dad's program, providing essential support and resources to help see them personally restored and impacting their families.

Through our partnership with **LIFEWISE ACADEMY:**

- **DEFIANCE** - 83% of students, Kindergarten through 5th grade, attended Lifewise Academy
- **AYERSVILLE** - 83% of students, 1st through 6th grade attended Lifewise Academy

NATIONAL I M P A C T

Goal: To help life-giving churches be planted and impact their community, to support victims being rescued and impacted by Christ, and to provide immediate relief to natural disaster areas

Through our partnership with **ARC**
(ASSOCIATION OF RELATED CHURCHES):

- **47 new churches** were launched worldwide in 2023
- **13,518 launch day attendance**
- **1,058 launch day salvations**
- **1,097 churches launched** through ARC since 2000



Through our partnership with **CHURCH BOOM:**

In 2022, the Church Rescue program coached, assisted, & resourced over 400 churches, many of these facing crisis and the threat of closing their doors. It also provided \$250,000 in emergency funding and resources to pastors and churches in need.



Through our partnership with **TRAFFICKING HOPE:**

Since launching in 2007, Trafficking Hope has:

- Identified or rescued over 1,200 sex trafficking victims
- Helped with over 650 arrests
- Reached over 545,000 through awareness and education



Through our partnership with **CONVOY OF HOPE:**

Since Convoy of Hope began in 1994, it has:

- Served more than 200 million people worldwide
- Given more than \$2 billion in food and supplies
- Helped with more than 625 worldwide disasters

DANIEL'S STORY

The months that led to my coming to Teen Challenge were the lowest months of my life. I was broken and lost. I needed a Savior. It took a while to understand that God has a plan for me, and that He loved me even when I was at my worst. Mountains were moved by God to get me to Teen Challenge when I was so undeserving. I was a drug dealer. I was very dangerous to both strangers and those who loved me. I was in and out of jail. I was on probation for assaulting the police. I was lost and blind to sin. My whole life was so tainted with abuse, neglect and abandonment that it never seemed wrong to do the things I'd done.

As I walk with God each day I no longer look to my past and see a criminal, a drug dealer, a dangerous person. I see a lost son searching for what he thought he needed: friends, money, women, things. But what I found at just the right time was God.

Goal: To fulfill the Great Commission through church planting, people coming to Christ, and nations being changed



Through partnerships in **BELIZE:**

- 1500 inmates at Belize Central Prison heard the gospel through Xperience Church prison ministry.
- Women's lives were transformed, including government officials, at the annual **Sisterhood Conferences** throughout Belize
- 800 volunteers from over 90 churches shared the love of Jesus through serving their communities on **Belize Serve Day**
- Hundreds of individuals received care through Belize's first **Mobile Medical Unit**.
