Missionary Status

Shell Lake Full Gospel Church (SLFG) welcomes everyone to our 2023 World Missions Conference. SLFG conducts a missionary conference each year to recognize missionaries, to provide encouragement and strength for their spirits, and to raise funds for the purpose of supporting projects and generating monthly support.

SLFG Member Missionaries

To become an SLFG member missionary, you will need to submit a missionary application and attend the conference for three years. After three years, SLFG's Mission Board will carefully process and pray over the applicant.

Consideration is given to qualification, suitability, relationship, field(s), conference capacity, and type of ministry.

If your application is accepted, you will be notified by a Mission Board member. If you are not accepted as a member missionary, you may still attend the conference but you will not be recognized as an SLFG member missionary.

The SLFG Missions Conference may not have the capacity to include new member missionaries. This is up to the discretion of the SLFG Missions Pastor and Mission Board.

Benefits to Member Missionaries

Missionaries may benefit greatly by being recognized as a missionary at an SLFG Missions Conference. Many pastors, ministry leaders, missionaries, and missions supporters attend each year, providing a rich environment for the broadening and deepening of relationships with other missions-minded Christians from around the world. Missionaries networking with other missionaries is a common experience as part of the conference benefits. Other benefits for registered SLFG Member Missionaries are:

- 1. Invitation to publicly greet the conference in person on stage
- 2. Displayed with a bio, picture, and a need in the missionary directory
- 3. Housing and some meals provided (as available)

Q and A

Q: Must I complete the registration process even though I have been introduced in the past as an SLFG member missionary?

A: Yes. SLFG requires full qualification and registration each year. A lot can change in one year and we want to make sure that every member is fully qualified for presentation at the conference.

Q: If I attend the SLFG conference, will all of my financial needs be met?


A: SLFG makes no guarantees concerning financial needs. Invited and registered member missionaries may have approved financial needs presented to the conference for prayerful consideration. Offerings received designated for a specific mission or member missionary will be forwarded as designated by the donor.

Q: I have a missionary friend whom I recommended to SLFG for presentation at the conference. Does he have to be invited by SLFG and go through the registration process, or may I just tell him to come?

A: Anyone may attend the conference, but there will be no missionaries presented as member missionaries who have not fully completed the registration process and have been accepted by the Missions Board. There will be no exceptions. If your friend would like to start the process to become a member missionary, have them complete a 'New Missionary Application'.

Q: If I attend the conference as a member missionary, will I be provided meals and a place to stay?

A: Yes and no. SLFG provides two meals (breakfast & lunch) per day, and one evening meal on Monday and Tuesday. SLFG does provide housing for our member missionaries only as they are made available. These are assigned by the SLFG Missions Conference Directors. When homes are not available, the missionary will be responsible to find their own housing or hotel accommodations during the conference. Those missionaries who have housing are asked to not arrive more than one day before, nor stay no longer than one day after the conference. SLFG will also seek to provide meals in homes for evening meals. This also will be according to availability.





ONE-TIME PLEDGES: One-time pledges to be made by January 1st or the date you indicate on your pledge form.

MONTHLY PLEDGES: Pledges given on a monthly basis to designated missionaries.

You may also indicate the money to be used "where needed most" and this will help us to provide funds, for emergency situations and other needs that missionaries face.

Please keep in mind that each missionary is dependent upon monthly support, as well as funds for specific projects that are listed in this book.
