



Job Title: Director of Worship

Church Overview: Christ Central Presbyterian Church is a Gospel-centered community that seeks to experience Gospel-renewal and extend Gospel-renewal to greater Metro D.C. Our vision is for the Gospel to bring spiritual, relational, and cultural renewal to greater Metro D.C. and the world. We exist to glorify God by multiplying and maturing Christ-centered disciples who love God, one another, our local communities, and the world. We are a congregation of the Presbyterian Church in America.

Job Summary: The Director of Worship exists to advance the vision, mission, and values of Christ Central by assisting the Pastor of Worship providing oversight, organizational leadership, strategic planning for the Worship Ministry.

Organizational Relationships: Reports to the Assistant Pastor that oversees the Worship Ministry.

Worship Ministry Responsibilities:

- Help oversee the Sunday Worship Ministry Teams (Praise, Production, Presiding, and Sound)
- Oversee Sunday Production Planning and Execution
- Recruit and train Production Team volunteers
- Maintain Worship Software and Video/Sound Equipment (Propresenter, Mixer, Server Room, Production equipment)
- Help oversee weekly Sunday Worship Rehearsals (as needed)
- Help prepare worship services for seasonal and special events i.e. holidays, church wide gatherings, leadership meetings, conferences (as needed)
- Manage logistics, scheduling, and worship service coordination through Planning Center

- Participate in CCPC staff meetings and retreats/conferences (as needed):
- Check notes on weekly tactical, monthly strategic planning (typically first Wednesday's of the month), staff development gatherings, staff planning retreat and other large ministry gatherings. In addition, participate in seasonal church- wide events and holiday services.
- Any other reasonable ministry requests made by the Assistant Pastor that oversees worship and/or the Senior Pastor

Qualifications as a Christ Central Director:

- Committed to Christ Central Presbyterian Church's vision, mission and values and goals, objectives, and needs
- Committed to fully engaging in the Christ Central's staff leadership team culture and church's community life
- Ability to work cooperatively and collaboratively with the entire church leadership (pastoral & ministry staff, elders/session, deacons, ministry team lay leaders)
- Ability to shepherd, support, train/develop and supervise the lay ministry volunteers
- Strong organizational and administrative skills
- Excellent written and oral communication skills
- Strong interpersonal and relationship building skills
- High level of professionalism, discernment, and discretion in dealing with confidential and sensitive issues
- Ability to clear all necessary background checks

Qualifications for Worship Director:

- Previous experience in leading, training and recruiting worship team members and overseeing Sunday Production ministry teams
- Technical experience in Sunday Production required (sound mixer, video, audio, stage & lighting)

Accountability and Supervision: Director of Worship will work under the oversight, supervision and direction of the Assistant Pastor that oversees worship and the Session. The Assistant Pastor that oversees worship will provide an annual staff review/appraisal and will update the job description (*if necessary*).
