SHARE BACKGROUND AND PROVIDE CONTEXT TO THE BIBLE STORY.

Author: Paul, Silas and Timothy
Audience: The church of the Thessalonians

Shortly after leaving Thessalonica to go South, Paul became worried about the community he left behind. Having dispatched Timothy and hearing his subsequent report, Paul wrote what is known to be the earliest letter in the New Testament — 1 Thessalonians. Timothy reported that many people at Thessalonica still had great affection for Paul, so Paul wrote them to provide assurance, comfort, gentle caution, conciliation, encouragement, and pastoral care. He wrote to encourage the followers of Christ to persevere in their Christian life. The thanksgiving section serves as an opportunity for Paul to remind the Thessalonians that during severe suffering, they were able to find joy in their relationship with one other as well as Christ.
