REVIVAL PRAYER EMPHASIS

SHARE BACKGROUND AND PROVIDE CONTEXT TO THE BIBLE STORY.

TAKE NOTICE! This week's story is similar to our most recent one in Acts 2 in the NT! This incredible revival experience comes right up to the doorstep of a historic, unforgettable, transformative shift in the history of God's people. The temple Solomon built was a dream come true. The temple was built to be where God's power would be on full display. A place where Jews both near and far would come to worship their King; a place to intimately experience God's presence in a real & personal way. But, the temple would always represent a place of holiness for a Holy God to dwell among His people. Any barriers or obstacles threatening holy communion with God would stop at the door. The entry fee to the temple was a Divine Faith marked by FULL SURRENDER and CONFESSION. Without this kind of faith, God could not be exalted or worshiped as He deserved to be!
