Share background and provide context to the Bible story.

Jesus and His disciples were gathered on the final night before His arrest.

He was preparing them for the reality that soon they would no longer walk beside

Him. In that moment, He gave them a picture of what true spiritual growth looks

like when He is no longer physically present.

He reminded them that growth isn't about effort or achievement but about staying connected to the source of life. He also explained that God actively shapes and refines those who belong to Him, removing what keeps them from becoming who they're meant to be. Through this teaching, Jesus pointed His followers toward a way of living marked by ongoing dependence, genuine love, and lasting joy. He used a familiar image to show them how their relationship with Him would continue and thrive even after His departure.
