Share background and provide context to the Bible story.

Jesus' journey "along the border between Samaria and Galilee" reflects a region marked by deep ethnic and religious division, as Jews considered Samaritans religiously compromised due to their mixed ancestry and unorthodox worship practices. Lepers were considered ritually unclean and were forced to live outside towns, cut off from family, worship, and economic life. Lepers formed their own communities for survival, often mixing ethnic groups, as seen in the presence of a Samaritan among the ten. The inclusion of a Samaritan, a group despised by Jews, highlights the radical inclusivity of Jesus' ministry and the breaking of ethnic and religious barriers. Jesus is traveling toward Jerusalem, intensifying His teachings on gratitude, faith, and the nature of true worship as He nears the cross...and now the story from God's Word.
