HOW WE LIVE THE MISSION

At The Met, everything we do flows from one purpose: Inviting people into meaningful relationship with God and each other.

TOTAL OPERATING BUDGET — \$4,747,929

As we look ahead, our budget allows us to:

- Continue reaching people with the hope of Jesus
- Disciple and equip families for spiritual growth
- Support local and global mission partners
- Provide excellent environments for worship, care, and community
- Invest in our staff and leaders who shepherd our church daily

This year's budget reflects a 4% increase from the previous year, driven by strategic investments in ministry growth, discipleship pathways, outreach, and rising operational costs.

As The Met grows, so does our calling to meet needs, serve families, and bring the hope of Jesus to our city and beyond. Your generosity in 2026 allows us to strengthen discipleship within our church and make a greater impact in Northwest Houston.

HOW DOES THE 2026 BUDGET COMPARE TO LAST YEAR'S BUDGET?

This year's budget represents a modest increase year-over-year, driven by continued growth in Kids and Student Ministries, new discipleship initiatives, expanded missions partnerships, and increased costs related to staff and facility care.

HOW WILL WE END THE 2025 FISCAL YEAR?

We anticipate finishing 2025 close to budget, with some areas of shortfall offset by careful spending and strong year-end generosity through Finish Strong. Our leadership continues to monitor giving and expenses closely, trusting God to meet every need through the faithful giving of His people.

IF WE ARE PROJECTING A SHORTFALL, WHY ARE WE INCREASING THE 2026 BUDGET?

This budget reflects both faith and stewardship. We believe the resources to accomplish the ministry God has set before us already exist within our church body. As we clarify needs and trust the Lord's prompting, we're confident He will provide. We'll continue to make wise, prayerful adjustments to remain financially healthy and mission-focused.

IF GOD INCREASED GIVING AMONG OUR MEMBERS, WHAT WOULD THE MET FOCUS ON?

Additional resources would allow us to accelerate strategic ministry initiatives—specifically discipleship development, missions expansion, and digital outreach—helping us reach more people with the hope of Jesus in Northwest Houston and beyond.
