The Videographer creates high-quality video content that advances Daybreak Church's mission and supports services, ministries, events, online experiences, and communication campaigns. This role includes filming, editing, producing, story development, and creating compelling visual media for digital platforms, social media, in-service experiences, and special events. The Videographer collaborates closely with the Creative & Communications Director and other ministry leaders to ensure visual storytelling remains excellent, aligned, and mission-focused. All of our staff embody and train others to Live and Love Like Jesus vision of the church.

Primary Responsibilities: What I am responsible for leading

- **Video Production & Filming -**
 - Capture high-quality footage for services, stories, promotions, and special events
 - Film both planned and spontaneous content, including interviews, sermons, testimonies, and b-roll
 - Support both campuses and off-site shoots as needed
- **Editing & Post-Production**
 - Edit video projects for weekend services, social media, YouTube, website, and internal uses
 - Create polished final content that reflects Daybreak's brand, tone, and visual standards
 - Manage color correction, audio cleanup, motion graphics, and final delivery
- **Creative Storytelling**
 - Help develop concept, script, and story arcs that inspire people to take next steps in faith
 - Work with ministry leaders to creatively capture testimonies, wins, and ministry impact
 - Ensure all stories reflect the heart of Daybreak's mission and values
- **Collaboration & Communication**
 - Work with the Creative & Communications Director to plan and prioritize weekly and seasonal projects.
 - Collaborate with all ministries in planning, brainstorming and executing video needs
- **Asset Management & Technical Excellence**
 - Maintain camera gear, lenses, audio equipment, lighting, and storage systems
 - Organize and manage video and photo files, archives, and backups.
 - Stay current with trends, equipment, and best practices in church media production.
- **Volunteer Development (Quadrant Leadership Model)**
 - Recruit, train, and mentor volunteer videographers or editors
 - Equip volunteers with skills in filming, editing, and storytelling
 - Implement Daybreak's Quadrant Leadership Model to build a multiplying team
