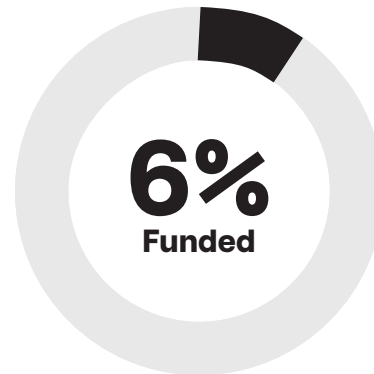


Lane One Daybreak Projects

The Daybreak Projects Lane is focused on the capital projects we are working on at Daybreak Church. Our goal is to keep our buildings and facilities on pace with our church's growth while at the same time working toward a debt-free position. As we look toward the future of Daybreak, we plan to resource and support multiple campuses that will become churches across the San Diego area.

Fully Funded Projects

Benevolence Fund 2025- Fully Funded at \$20,000

At Daybreak, we show the love of Jesus to individuals in need by offering benevolence. Our Benevolence fund allows us to offer a little support to people experiencing financial hardship.

Current Projects

Debt Elimination - \$411,015 Toward Debt Reduction

We currently pay \$24,000 per month towards the principle of the loan on the Worship Center. \$416,015 has been given toward debt reduction by the Kingdom Builders team, leaving \$7,735,233 left on the loan. This is our only outstanding loan, and the Elders and Leadership Council are committed to not taking out any additional loans on the Carlsbad property.

Solar Power - \$40,000 of \$250,000 Funded

As a result of this investment, Daybreak can realize a savings of \$63,000 per year. Over a 10-year period, it would add up to over \$500,000 in savings, which will go to further expanding and advancing the mission God has called us to accomplish.

New Projects

Benevolence Fund 2026 - \$0 of \$30,000 Funded

At Daybreak, we show the love of Jesus to individuals in need by offering benevolence. Our Benevolence fund allows us to offer a little support to people experiencing financial hardship.



Because You Gave

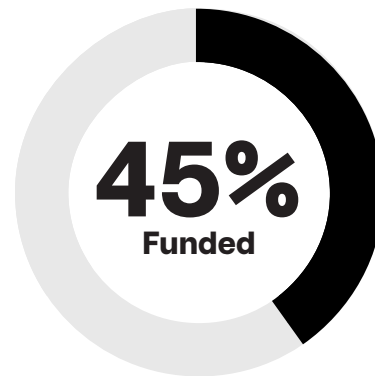
Lane Two Next Generation

Fully Funded Projects

Youth Outreach Programs for 2025/26 - Fully Funded at \$30,000

We were able to fund campus clubs, school outreach and two Future Nights on the Daybreak Campus.

Youth Leadership Development & Mission Trip Program for 2025/26 - Fully Funded at \$20,000

Creating and executing disciple leadership programs that equip 8th graders for high school and 12th graders for college and beyond to represent Jesus well.

Regional “For the Future” Conference for 2025 - Fully Funded at \$20,000

Training youth pastors around the nation how to establish campus clubs and provide grants to Youth Pastors who want to implement this in their ministries.

New Projects

Youth Outreach Programs for 2026/27 - \$0 of \$50,000 Funded

Continued funding for campus clubs, school outreach and support for two Future Nights on the Daybreak Campus.

Camp Scholarships - \$0 of \$10,000 Funded

At youth camp, students encounter Jesus in life-changing ways. The Youth Camp Scholarship Fund makes camp more accessible for students to experience God’s calling, despite the cost.

Youth Leadership Development & Mission Trip Program for 2026/27 - \$0 of \$25,000 Funded

The development of a discipleship program that equips 8th graders for high school and 12th graders for college and beyond to represent Jesus well.

Daybreak Kids - We hosted Kids Camp for the very first time! What an incredible launch year, 88 kids came to camp and encountered Jesus, built friendships, and grew in their faith.

Youth Baptisms - 30+ students were baptized in service during YTH Sunday night during the 2024-25 school year.

Youth Outreach - 200+ students at Carlsbad High School's first club of Fall 2025.

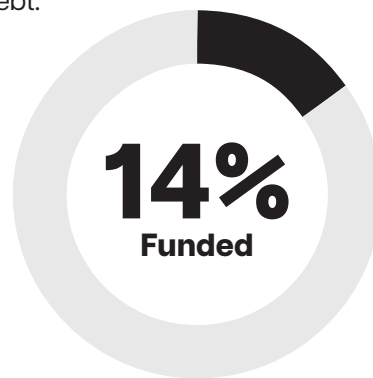


Lane Three Daybreak Leadership College

This lane is focused on our calling to raise up the next generation of Christ-centered church leaders, missionaries, business leaders and world influencers. These projects are focused on continuing to establish Daybreak Leadership College (DLC) as a one-of-a-kind ministry learning and preparation institution, while ensuring the cost remains affordable to allow these future church leaders to launch ministry careers with minimal debt.

Fully Funded

DLC 2024/25 Operating Costs - Fully Funded at \$250,000

This covers the staffing and operating expenses incurred in running the Leadership College while allowing costs to remain low to the students so they do not carry significant loans into ministry careers.

DLC Dormitory Site Acquisition - Fully Funded at \$35,000

Through a mutli-step approval process, with associated costs and consultation, we have been approved for zoning, delveoping, and building new DLC dorms on the Meadowlark Ranch property.

New Projects

DLC 2025/26 Operating Costs - \$0 of \$295,000 Funded

This will cover the staffing and operating expenses incurred in running the Leadership College while allowing costs to remain low to the students so they do not carry significant loans into ministry careers.

DLC Dormitory Site Development - \$0 of \$1,350,000 Funded

There is a 3-step process with the county to pursue approvals for building the dorms. There is an initial Consultation Meeting, followed by a Major Project Pre-Application Meeting. Finally, we will need to submit the Major Use Permit in order to prepare for, and gain, approval to modify the property. We are working with a zoning attorney, architect, and land developer to push this initial phase through the county offices for approval.

DLC 2026/27 Scholarship Fund - \$0 of \$60,000 Funded

This fund allows us to offer scholarships to help make college and ministry a more affordable reality for ministry-minded students at DLC who need financial assistance.



Because You Gave

Growth - Our student body doubled again this year to 33 full-time students, with students coming from five states and three countries!

Scholarships - Six students received scholarships for the 2025/26 school year through the Kingdom Builders scholarship fund. This positions students for successful transition into ministry careers with limited or no debt.

Impact - This year we saw our student body double in size, and they invested 8,500 hours of into ministry and service, across all areas of our church.

Prayer Points

Student Impact

- For the Holy Spirit to continue to draw students with a definitive call to ministry to our program
- Our expanding student body would experience significant personal growth, vibrant community, and life-transformative ministry

Strategy

- Marketing efforts would be effective, particularly with high school seniors and others looking to determine their plans for the Fall 2026/27 year
- That strategic efforts to further develop and shape our college for expanded scope and reach would be fruitful and effective, positioning us for greater impact

Kingdom Builder Role

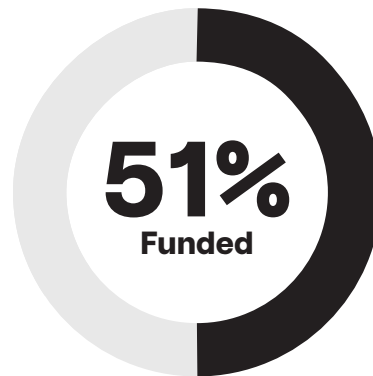

Lane Four Church Multiplication

Daybreak has a long history of supporting church multiplication through the resourcing of church planters, as well as planting churches– most recently having planted Discover Church in San Marcos. This lane is focused on future campuses and church plants in the San Diego area. This includes campuses we will be launching, as well as church plants we feel called to financially support.

Daybreak at Meadowlark Ranch Launch - Fully Funded at \$47,900

This initiative covers the costs of launching a new campus with preparations such as a new Worship Center, bathrooms & classroom renovations.

Discover Church in San Marcos - Fully Funded at \$500,000

Discover Church officially launched its first service at Mission Hills High School on September 21, 2025. On that day, more than 500 people gathered to worship, celebrate, and experience the start of a new move of God, bringing the love of Christ to their community in a powerful new way.

New Projects

Daybreak at Meadowlark Ranch Worship Center Construction - \$0 of \$500,000 Funded

This initiative is to cover the costs of launching a new campus with preparations such as a new Worship Center, bathrooms & classroom renovations.

Santa Barbara Church Plant - \$0 of \$35,000 Funded

We're excited to partner with The Father's House Network to support a new church plant in Santa Barbara, a city with few thriving churches like Daybreak. Led by Pastors Jude and Becky Fouquier, this new church is anticipated to launch in spring 2026.

Because You Gave

Daybreak at Meadowlark Ranch Launch - This investment allowed us to prepare the pre-existing Meadowlark property to begin holding weekly services this past September with new audio visual equipment and necessary upgrades to kids classrooms and systems.

Discover Church Launch - Your investment covered startup expenses, such as salary, furniture, and rent, allowing the Discover Church team to celebrate a successful launch at Mission Hills High School.

Together Church in Sacramento Launch - Together Church is a church plant that launched in May, in a tough neighborhood in West Sacramento. We are glad to have been able to give toward their launch and help make their vision of reaching the lost and the hurting a reality.

Prayer Points

- Continued clarity and discernment on the Daybreak at Meadowlark transition timeline and plan
- Favor with current Meadowlark Church Attendees as they adjust to a new way of doing church
- Pray for our launch team's continued excitement and momentum as we prepare our systems and services for the Daybreakers who will eventually call Daybreak at Meadowlark Ranch their church home
- The softening of the community around Daybreak at Meadowlark to a new and vibrant church in their neighborhood
- No interruptions to renovation plans and timelines

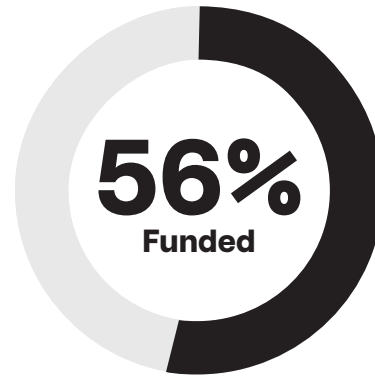


Lane Five Missions

Build 10 Homes in Tijuana - Fully Funded at \$35,000

San Diego Rescue Mission 2025 - Fully Funded at 35,000

Renovation of an additional apartment in the downtown SDRM center to support those in need getting back on their feet.

Meal Packing with Kids Around the World 2025 - Fully Funded at \$35,000

In July, Daybreakers packed and provided 100,440 meals to refugees in Northern Uganda. Thanks to your generosity 463 children now have access to a daily meal for the entire school year!

Church Construction in Kenya - Fully Funded at \$23,400

Because of your faithfulness, the Siloam Church community in Southern Kenya now has a safe place to gather in worship. Through your giving, God allowed the believers in this remote Maasai village to complete the roof, floors, windows, and wiring for their house of worship.

Well in Kenya - Fully Funded at \$43,000

We are working with our brothers and sisters in Christ at Cornerstone Faith Assembly in partnership with Africa Thriving to drill a well, bringing water and sharing the Gospel to remote villages in the Maasai land.

Renovation of an additional apartment in the downtown SDRM center to support those in need getting back on their feet.

New Projects Cont.

Meal Packing with Kids Around the World 2026 - \$0 of \$50,000 Funded

Kids Around The World is working to not only address hunger but to foster unity, and bring hope by providing food and sharing God's love with others. \$50,000 covers the cost of 150,000 meals we can share with children in need. Last year our church packed 100,000 meals together on a Sunday!

Church Planter Training in East Africa - \$0 of \$50,000 Funded

Continue to partner with Cornerstone Church and Dynamic Church Planters International (DCPI) to help equip more pastors to share the Gospel in remote areas throughout East Africa. Through their program, each trained leader is expected to plant an average of 2.55 churches over the course of 5 years based on past data.

Because You Gave

San Diego Rescue Mission

Because you gave, the downtown SDRM center has an additional newly refurbished apartment that will provide a safe, supportive space for some of San Diego's homeless neighbors to find restoration, rehabilitation, and hope as they get back on their feet.

Kids Around the World Food Distribution

Because of your generosity and service, 100,440 meals were assembled and shipped for distribution among refugees in Northern Uganda. Thanks to Daybreak's meal packing event hosted in July, 463 children now have access to a daily meal for their entire school year, and get to experience God's love and provision through the generosity of others!

Kenya Church Construction

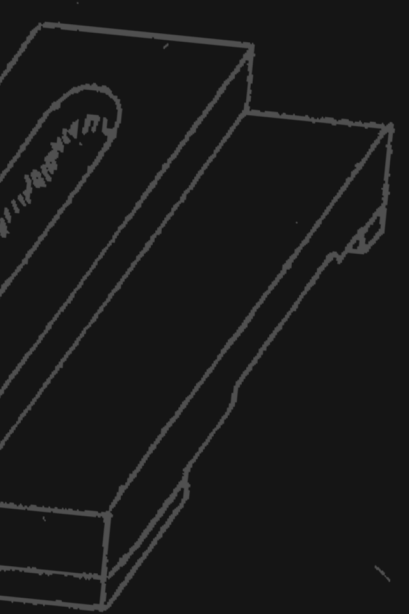
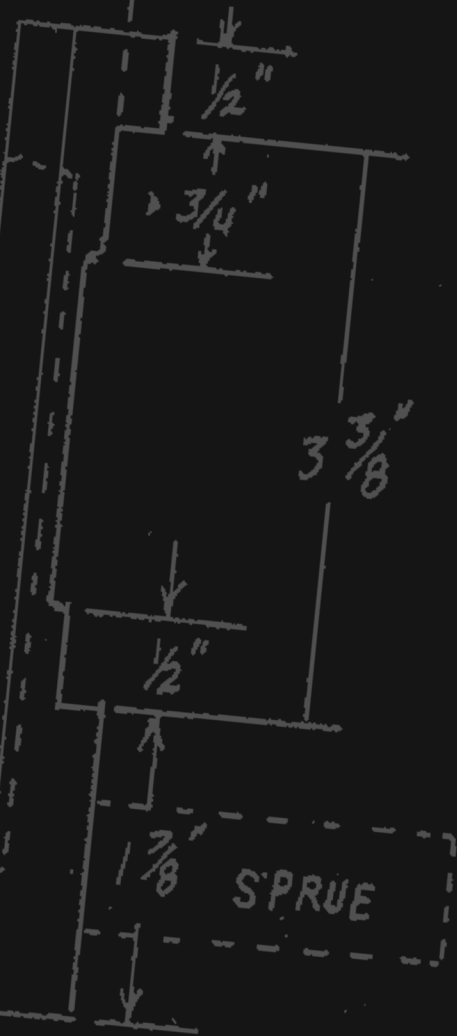
