



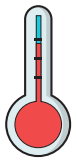
WELLNESS POLICY

Dear Families,

At Together Church, we are committed to providing a safe and clean environment for all children in our care. To ensure the health and well-being of every child, we kindly ask that you review and adhere to the following illness

Children exhibiting any signs of illness, such as a runny nose, persistent cough, fever, or similar symptoms, will not be admitted to our Nursery or Grade School ministries to protect the health of all participants. If a child becomes ill during their time with us, you will be contacted immediately to pick them up. The safety and wellness of our children remain our top priority.

Please refer to the following guidelines regarding illnesses:



Fever

Children must be fever-free without medication for at least 24 hours.



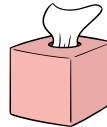
Nausea, Vomiting, or Diarrhea

Children must be symptom-free for 48 hours before returning.



Common cold or excessive cough.

Sneezing, runny nose, or sore throat.
Constant coughing, possibly with phlegm.



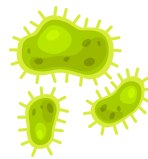
Heavy Nasal Discharge

Green.



Chickenpox

All sores must be completely scabbed over and dry.



Symptoms of contagious childhood diseases

scarlet fever, measles, strep throat, COVID or flu, ECT.



Lice



Unexplained rashes.

Infections such as boils, ringworm, thrush, hand-foot-mouth disease, fifth disease, etc.

If any sickness has affected your household, individuals who are symptom-free or no longer contagious may participate in campus activities. We ask that you apply the Golden Rule: "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you."

Please exercise extra caution when volunteering or sending a child to our Bed Babies program. Thank you for helping us maintain a healthy environment for all our children and families.
