CONVERSATION QUESTIONS:

- As you think about the "women of faith" in Scripture, is there one you love and relate to? If so, who and why?
- Brannon shared five reasons for covering a series on women. Which explanation
 he gave resonated with or challenged you most deeply and why? (Cultural,
 Biblical, personal, corrective, Gospel)
- Have you ever felt defined by your inability? How have you seen God meet you in and work through that?
- "God often lets us taste our own faithlessness just long enough so that we can hate it." How have you seen that statement to be true?



- Pastor Brannon said, "Events of my life reveal my identity, but they don't have to remain my identity." How does that resonate with you?
- "Is anything too hard for the LORD?" This is the question of faith Abraham and Sarah needed to hear that revealed the faithlessness of their hearts and the faithfulness of God. In what ways can you remember the faithfulness of God in your life?
- Saving faith is not faith in my ability to believe. Saving faith is faith in God's ability to do what He says. // Read 2 Corinthians 5:21 and thank God for His work.
