


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Welcome to the Adventure Church Dream Teams!

Dream Team Values

Reliable

Definition: A reliable person is consistent in their attitude, service, and communication.

Cafe Crew

Vision

To facilitate fellowship and community through coffee conversations

Overview

Expectations

- Be in place at the café an hour before service begins to prepare the café and brew coffee
- Make and serve coffee as needed before, during, and after service.
- Stock coffee, cups, creamers, and all other supplies as needed
- Clean up the café and empty/clean the coffee containers
- Have fun!

Cleaning Crew

Vision

To create a clean and welcoming environment

Overview

Do you have an eye for detail? Are you passionate about creating excellent environments for people to experience Christ? Or just naturally an organized and clean person? Then our Cleaning Crew is the place for YOU! Our Cleaning Crew ensures that every service is set up for success by making sure our building is clean and free of distractions.

Expectations

- Vacuuming
- Mopping
- Cleaning restrooms
- Emptying trash
- Wiping down surfaces

Serving and Scheduling: This team typically serves outside of Sunday services during the week. Schedules may be flexible. Requests for the current month are emailed around the 15th the prior month via Planning Center Services. You may use the block out feature on planning center to let us know dates you will not be available to serve.

Connections Team

Vision

To make a final lasting impression on our first-time guest

Overview

Connections team aims to welcome, inform, and serve our first-time guests. This team is helping our new guest make their final connection before exiting their worship experience.

Expectations

- Commit to serve at minimum, one-two service per month
- Be at the connect center before the end of service for at least 15 mins after service ends
- Appearance should be clean, neat, casual appropriate
- Always be pleasant, smiling, and ready to greet our firsttime guests.
- Small talk is key introduce yourself, collect Connect Card (physical or virtually) & make sure info is legible, ask how they heard about AC, welcome them back
- · Hand new guest their free gift
- Be prepared to answer any general questions about AC
- Help sell merchandise and hand out special information.
- Have fun!

Events Team

Vision

To make following Jesus Fun

Overview

Our Events Team helps to plan and execute community events and family events. This allows our organizational and creative people to help organize volunteers, plan decorations and themes, as well as help execute the events the day of.

Expectations

- Available, as needed, to plan events and execute events
- Be prepared to bring creative ideas to the table
- Own tasks assigned during meetings
- Be organized and detailed to ensure successful events

Vision

To help teens discover new life in Christ

Overview

Hype Youth Ministries focuses on creating a highly energetic and relational environment that ensures teens to grow in their relationship with others and with Jesus. A typical Hype Night includes fun games, an encouraging message, and transformative life groups. Our team is primarily Life Group Leaders hungry to invest in the next generation. Other areas of involvement include security, snack shack, and set-up/tear down. - Commit to serve at minimum two Wednesdays per month
- Arrive 45 minutes early for volunteer meetings and service run-through
- Facilitate group conversation using the questions provided
- Seek to build relationships with the students in your group outside of Hype
- Have fun!

Host Team Greeter & Usher

Vision

We set the table for a God experience

Overview

We want everyone to feel appreciated when they walk into Adventure Church. Greeters and ushers are some of the first points of contact for our church. Hosts are responsible for welcoming every person that comes to our church and are stationed at specific locations to engage and connect with visitors as soon as they enter. As a Host Team member, you are one of the very first impressions our guests will have of our church. Let's help them to feel at home!

Expectations

Commit to serve at minimum, one-two service per month

- Arrive 30 minutes prior to scheduled service time, huddle with Head Usher
- Appearance should be clean, neat, casual appropriate
- Be aware of all guests to set a welcoming environment
- Be on the lookout for new guest and help them find their way around campus
- Be helpful and answer questions as needed
- Ushers will help guest finds seat in the auditorium
- Return to position before service is over for 15 mins
- Have fun! We do want you to make connections with other team members but remember that our priority is helping all our guests

Kidventure

Vision

To provide a safe, secure, and loving environment for children where every child and parents feels comfortable, and at the same time learns about God and connects with kids their age.

Overview

A kids ministry focused on teaching Godly values in a fun, active environment. This ministry is designed for all children from birth to 5th grade.

Expectations

- Commit to serve at minimum, one service per month
- Arrive 20 minutes prior to scheduled service time
- Wear proper attire to interact with children (you will be given a Kidventure t-shirt that you will need to wear when you serve)
- Have fun! We do want you to make connections with other team members but remember that our priority is the children so during service we ask that your focus is on them.

Kidventure Check-in & Check-out Team

Vision

To provide a safe, secure, and loving environment for children where every child and parents feels comfortable, and at the same time learns about God and connects with kids their age.

Overview

Our Kids check-in and check-out team is the first spot in our church family's journey as they drop off their kids into Kidventure. This team is vital in welcoming our families and also ensuring the safety of the children by ensuring each one is checked in properly.

Expectations

- Commit to serve at minimum, one-two services per month
- Arrive at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled service time
- Set up all computers and printers
- Welcome all guests and point them to available check-in stations
- Remain in position for 15 minutes once service starts
- Assist new families by helping them check-in and help them find their way
- Return to position before service ends to help the flow of foot traffic and if anyone loses a pickup tag.
- Have fun! We do want you to make connections with other team members but remember that our priority is our families walking in.

Security Team

Vision

To protect and serve our church family

Overview

We want everyone to feel safe and secure when they attend Adventure Church. Safety and Security team members are some of the first points of contact for our church. Team members are responsible for being visible, available, and welcoming to every person that comes to our church. They are stationed at specific locations to engage guests as soon as they enter. A special focus is on our children, always providing a safe and secure environment for them to learn about God. Team members are committed to knowing and being able to execute the safety and security plans should the need arise. We will take authentic ownership in our service to God and his church.

Expectations

- Arrive at least 30 minutes before the service begins. Get your security lanyard and radio and ensure it's in working order. Check-in with your team leader.
- Welcome and greet all people. If there is someone you don't know, please shake their hand and introduce yourself while welcoming them to the church.
- Be very intentional with everyone you interact with. Check proper doors before service starts.
- Stay in position for the entire service to ensure security of your area

Production Team

Vision

To Create an engaging and distraction free environment for people to encounter Jesus.

Overview

Production is responsible for the look and feel of our Sunday experience. We believe in creating a distraction free worship environment that supports the movement of God in the hearts and lives of everyone who walks through the doors.

Expectations

- Due to the nature of production, we require our team to serve at all services. This ensures that we stay consistent throughout all services.
- Arrive at least 2 before the service begins.
- Prior to service we have a 1 hour rehearsal time, 15 minute meeting, 40 minute final service run through.
- During Rehearsal we check all service elements and make adjustments as needed
- During the final run through we go through the service from start to finish.
- Doors open 15 minutes before service starts.
- Should be in positions 10 minutes before service start time.

Prayer Team

Vision

To partner with our church family through prayer and intercede.

Overview

The Prayer Team is a vital part of Adventure Church. They support those in our church family that need a partner in prayer during our services, and throughout the week.

Ephesians 6:18 "And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people."

Expectations

- Check in 10 minutes before the worship experience begins.
- When the worship leader calls for prayer partners, proceed to the back of the auditorium.
- Pray with those individuals that come to meet you.
- All prayer requests are confidential.
- If there are ever any questions concerning the prayer need, please notify a church staff member.

Worship Team

Vision

To lead the way for people to experience God's presence

Overview

The Worship Team is essential in creating an atmosphere that helps experience God's presence.

Expectations

- Model worship for the church through your attitudes and actions.
- Strive to play your instrument to your greatest potential with excellence as unto the Lord.
- Attend scheduled rehearsals, services, and ministry events punctually.
- Serve during all services
- Dress in a modest manner that reflects your role in this ministry.
- Be responsible for your own instrument and sheet music, keeping your area neat and in order.
- Strive to set an example, both onstage and off, of godly behavior.
