Today's Adult Bible Class: Islam and Our Faithful God. At the heart of a Christian analysis of Islam is our understanding of God - he has all power, all knowledge, and all love. Yet he allows things we struggle to comprehend, such as Islam. Approximately 2 billion Muslims worldwide believe Jesus is only a prophet and hold to the Quran's teachings that he did not die or rise. Yet these same 2 billion are sinners for whom Christ died, just like you and I, and the vast majority are trying to do what is right and live in peace with their neighbors. Today's topic—Islam through the Eyes of Muslims—allows us to appreciate Islam for what it is while pointing out—with a sense of compassion—what these two billion souls without the Gospel of Christ are lacking. *Pastor Tom Lange will lead this class in the gym.*
