Annual Meeting Recap: On May 31 over 200 people and more than 140 voters gathered for our annual meeting. We unanimously approved our 2026–27 ministry outcomes and budget; elected new members to our Church Council, Board of Elders, and School Board; amended the bylaws to clarify the terms of our President and Vice-President; and, in a 122–12 vote, approved the construction of our Phase 1A narthex addition. Together we celebrated God's gracious gifts among us and asked for His continued blessings on our work and witness. *Thank you for the role you play in our preaching, teaching, and reaching!*
