Dear RBC Family,

The devil hates you and has a horrible plan for your life. How's that for an opening line? You encouraged yet? It's tough but it's true. And the devil has a horrible plan for the church as well. Every time the Spirit of God moves among people, you can be certain that Satan will seek to hinder the work.



The reality of such spiritual warfare is evident in Acts 13:1–12. The early church, aflame with God's heart for the nations, sets apart Paul and Barnabas and the first missionaries. The church fasts, prays, and commissions them to bring the Gospel to distant lands. And the missionaries head out aboard a ship and sailed to Cyprus. Upon arrival, they begin preaching the gospel, and one of the local leaders, Sergius Paulus, was increasingly interested in the good news of Jesus Christ. But at that very moment, the devil began to rage. A sorcerer began to oppose the gospel, working to turn Sergius away from faith in Christ. But Paul, full of the Spirit, confronted the demonized sorcerer with the word of God, and God won a great victory that day as Sergius believed.

I am convinced that there were two critical factors in the victory over the devil that day. First, there was a church praying. Second, there was a faithful minister proclaiming truth. Prayer and the truth—those are our weapons of righteousness.

RBC family, as we seek to move forward with the Gospel, we must expect to encounter supernatural resistance. And we must be ready to counter with intense prayer and with God's word.

Words from Wells...



“You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus, for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.” (Galatians 3:26-27)

Let's have a quick lesson, and then make some application to our lives. The first part, “You are all sons of God...” is used many times out of context. You have probably heard someone say that we are all children of God. That's not correct! We are not all ‘children of God’. Look at the verse again—“Sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus”. It is our faith in Jesus that makes us children of God! Then notice the rest of that sentence; all God's children have “clothed yourselves with Christ”. That's what people see on the outside—our clothing. If I'm wearing old, torn jeans and beat up boots, you know I am going to work in my yard. If I'm wearing a suit and tie, you know there is something important to go to.

Let's make some application to these verses. If you are a child of God, which means you have put your faith in Jesus Christ and Him alone for your salvation, then what shows on the outside is going to reflect Christ in your life. Our actions, our words, even our attitudes should reflect Christ. What do people see in our lives at the grocery store on Tuesday afternoons? Or at the hardware store on Saturday mornings? Do our words and attitudes still reflect Christ? *May we all be good reflectors of Jesus every place, every day of the week!*
