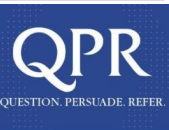


A note from David and Nancy Slinde

Nancy and I were missionaries in El Salvador from 2009 thru 2012. On our days off we visited ancient cities uncovered from volcanic ash, Mayan temples, museums featuring Mayan art works and art museums featuring very modern art. We have a few items in our possession that will be on display in the hearth room between services on **Sunday, March 10th**. The Mayan items are copies of items found in museums dating back 500 to 600 years ago. The current art forms are on paper, canvas, porcelain, wood and fabric. Some are from student artists we knew. There is no presentation, but we will be there to answer questions.

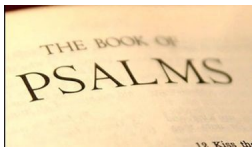
