*SCRIPTURE OF THE DAY: John 3:14-21 The Lord is with you. And also with you. A reading from the Gospel according to John. Glory to you, O Lord. Just as Moses

lifted up the snake in the wilderness, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, that everyone who believes may have eternal life in him. For God so loved the world that in the fullness of time he sent his only Son so that those who believe would not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son. This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil.
