*PROCESSIONAL GOSPEL: Mark 11:1-10 Listen to Jesus' entry into Jerusalem. The Gospel of the Lord. Praise to you O Christ!

*BLESSING OF PALMS: The Lord be with you. And also with you. Let us pray. We praise you, O God, for redeeming the world through our Savior, Jesus Christ. Today he entered the holy city in triumph and was proclaimed Messiah and king by those who spread garments and branches along his way. Bless + these branches and those who carry them. May they remind us to shout Hosanna in our homes, workplaces and schools. We pray these blessings and graces in the name of Jesus: AMEN!

*PROCESSION: Let us go forth in peace, in the name of the Lord. AMEN! (We will process into sanctuary while the singing Hosanna. All process to places in their respective pews.)

*PRAYER OF THE DAY: Let us pray: Council Blessing

CHOIR MEDITATION: He is Exalted

PASSION PRESENTATION: (May this short video help us to shout "Hosanna" recognizing the gift of Jesus present in our lives today.)

COUNCIL BLESSING: We pray over and bless our 2024 church council.

*HOLY COMMUNION: Rejoice in this holy meal offered to us. Christ invites all of God's people to share in this banquet for this is the meal of God for the people of God. Thanks be to God!

You are invited to come forward down the center aisle to receive baked bread and then dip that bread into the glass of red wine or juice. Gluten free bread is available as well. For those who prefer, communion kits are available in a basket near the front of the sanctuary. All are welcome to share in this meal with us!

PRAYER AFTER COMMUNION: Let us pray together: Holy God, you have fed us with the gifts of your table. Amen.
