Hosea 5:15ff, Zech 12:10ff, Roman 11:25-27


Day of Atonement


Lord's Return awaits Israel's Response Hosea prophesied that Messiah awaits the day of Israel's Repentance.

In their affliction they will earnestly seek Me." Hos 5:15 NKJV




















Traditional Prayers of Yom Kippur

Ashamnu (we have scoffed or we have misled others) AI Chet (for the sin)- Prayer of 44 statements repeated 10X

during Yom Kippur services

Each confessional prayers is followed by prayers in which they seek forgiveness.

Al Chet Prayer (Confession)

- For the sin that we have sinned before You under duress and willingly; And for the sin that we have sinned before You through hardness of heart.
- For the sin that we have sinned before You without knowledge; And for the sin that we have sinned before You with the utterance of our lips.




- For the sin we have sinned before You with haughty eyes; And for the sin we have sinned before You with brazenness.
- For all these, o God of forgiveness forgive us, pardon us, atone for us.
- (Christians can say- THANK YOU FOR YOU HAVE ATONED FOR OUR SIN.





Micah 7:18-19


