
Nebuchadnezzar King of Babylon



Antiochus IV Epiphanes The King of the North





In the 153rd year, Antiochus Epiphanes marched against Jerusalem with a great army. In arrogance he entered the holy sanctuary, plundered the golden altar, lampstand, table of showbread, sacred vessels, and even stripped away the ornamentation of the Temple itself. He seized all treasures and returned to his land, leaving Israel in deep mourning.

Two years later, Antiochus sent his officer Apollonius to Jerusalem. Speaking peaceably, he deceived the people, then suddenly struck the city, slaughtering many, burning houses, tearing down walls, and carrying women and children into captivity. He fortified the city of David and stationed lawless men there, turning it into a constant threat against the sanctuary. Blood was shed around the holy place, the sanctuary was defiled, the feasts turned into mourning, Sabbaths into shame, and Jerusalem into a desolation. 9/14/25


Antiochus then issued an edict to his whole kingdom: all peoples must abandon their customs and be one people. He commanded the Jews to profane the Sabbaths and feasts, cease sacrifices, pollute the sanctuary, forsake circumcision, and build altars for idols. Swine and unclean animals were to be sacrificed, and anyone found keeping the Law was to be put to death. Many in Israel abandoned the covenant, but others hid themselves in faithfulness.


On the 15th day of Chislev, in the 145th year, they set up upon the altar the "abomination of desolation." They sacrificed swine upon the holy altar, destroyed every copy of the Law they could find, and killed those who possessed it. Women who circumcised their sons were slain with their children hung around their necks. Families were executed for keeping the covenant. Yet many in Israel stood firm, choosing death rather than to eat unclean food or break the holy covenant. Thus great wrath came upon Israel.





























Sudden rise to power:
