

A Revelation Parallel Vision -CHAPTER 8 – GOLDEN CENSOR OF FIRE THROWN TO EARTH -CHAPTER 14-15 – 7 GOLDEN BOWLS OF WRATH THROWN TO EARTH and --Both were answer to prayers of saints – 5:8, 6:10, 8:3

WRATH is the Shared Event that allows Connection of the 7 Seals, 7 Trumpets & 7 Bowls of Wrath!



Wrath Connects Seals, Trumpets, & Bowls

- → 6th seal WRATH Revelation 6:12, 16-17
- 12 When he opened the sixth seal,....
- ¹⁶..."Fall on us and hide us from the face of him who is seated on the throne, and from the **WRATH** of the Lamb, ¹⁷ for the great day of their **WRATH** has come, and who can stand?"
- → 7th Trumpet WRATH Revelation 11:15-18
- ¹⁵ Then the seventh angel blew his trumpet...
- ¹⁸ The nations raged, but your wrath came...
- → 7 Bowls of WRATH Revelation 15:7

Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls **full of the wrath of** God

Dr. Richard Booker on God's Wrath

God is always holy, just, loving, good, and merciful toward sinners- while simultaneously, his moral, holy anger called wrath, burns against sin. His wrath is not passing emotion as with humans. It comes from within His nature and is eternal just as He is eternal.

Dr. Richard Booker on God's Wrath

Because God is morally perfect, His holy nature requires that the judgment for sin must be separation from Him...God's just nature requires that the judgment be paid.

Yet God's goodness and mercy do not desire us to pay the judgment ourselves. God's love came to earth and paid the judgment for us in the person of Jesus of Nazareth. This is the story of the Bible from beginning to end.
