The Stages of Marriage in Judaism

- Husband's Father/Parents select Bride (shidduch)
- A Written Marriage Contract is agreed upon and signed by the Groom and Bride's Father (<u>Ketubah</u>)
- A bride price is paid by the groom to bride's father (<u>Mohαr</u>)
- The couple are now betrothed (erusin) declared husband and wife, legally binding as married but do not live together or have sexual relations.

The Stages of Marriage in Judaism

- •After the betrothal, the groom would return to his father's house and build a room onto the family home (<u>insula</u>) to prepare a new home for his wife
- After a period of time, the groom would return for his wife and they would consummate the marriage (*Nissuin*) and there would be a 7-day wedding feast
