



Siloam Inscription

- 8th century BC Hebrew inscription chiseled into the wall inside Pool of Siloam
- Tells of Hezikiah's project mentioned in Bible in 2 Kings and 2 Chron
- Stone dates to the time of Hezikiah








Coins Found During Excavation of Pilgrim Road



Minimalist

Give little to no value to Biblical texts, particularly Old Testament.

- Bible not reliable historically or archeologically
- View Bible as collection of myths rather than factual.

Maximalist

Accept biblical narratives as valid historical accounts and use archeology to support these narratives.

Argue that the lack of evidence does'nt necessarily disprove biblical events.





The Ophel (circled in red)


Location of archeological dig conducted by Dr. Eilat Mazar, archeologist from the Hebrew University.



Evidence of written communication between the King of Assyria and the King of Judah




