Presence Defines The House 1 Kings 8:6-11

- ▶ The Ark is brought into the Most Holy Place
- ▶ Gods covenant is placed at the center
- ▶ Obedience precedes manifestation
- ▶ God responds to divine order
- ▶ Gods presence, not activity, defines the house.

Posture Precedes Power

1 Kings 8:22

- ▶ Solomon stands before the altar (alignment)
- ▶ Hands are lifted towards heaven (surrender)
- ▶ Eyes are lifted towards heaven (expectation)
- ▶ Prayer comes before direction
- ▶ Leadership is submitted before it is exercised

A House Designed For Return

1 Kings 8:33-36

- ▶ Covenant anticipates human failure
- ▶ Repentance is assumed, not shamed
- ▶ God welcomes returning hearts
- ▶ Restoration is central to Gods design

A House of Prayer For All People

1 Kings 8:41-43

- ▶ The foreigner is included
- ▶ God's name is known beyond Israel
- ▶ Prayer extends beyond God's people
- ▶ God's presence has global purpose
- ▶ Israel is displaying the presence of God

Call To Wholehearted Dedication

1 Kings 8:61

- ▶ Hearts must be wholly devoted
- ▶ Obedience matters moving forward
- ▶ Dedication became a way of life
- ▶ Faithfulness is required of the people
- ▶ The future depended on devotion
